**<u>DUTIES</u>**: Under direction of a supervisory official in the Youth Justice Commission, conducts behavioral adjustment hearings and renders decisions, assists in the parole revocation or probable cause review process, makes all decisions in accordance with associated policies, rules, and regulations; does other related duties as required. ## **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Five (5) years of experience in a professional position directly related to parole.

**NOTE:** A JD or LLB may be substituted for three (3) years of the required experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
