<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the close supervision of a Weights and Measures Inspector 3 or other supervisory official, in a three-year training program, performs productive work while receiving formal and on-the-job training in the inspection and testing of weighing and measuring devices; does other related duties as required. Please see the Civil Service Commission (CSC) job specification for additional information: <u>info.csc.state.nj.us/jobspec/04201.htm</u>.

REQUIREMENTS

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey. Appointees may also be required to possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsements for the class and type of vehicle being operated.

NOTE: Appointees will be required to successfully complete the Weights and Measures training program conducted by the State Office of Weights & Measures, Department of Law and Public Safety, during the apprenticeship program.

<u>ADVANCEMENT:</u> Appointee's work performance will be reviewed and rated semi-annually during each twelve (12) months of the three (3) year apprenticeship program. Upon successful completion of the thirty-six (36) month apprenticeship program, appointees will be eligible for advancement to the title of Weights and Measures Inspector 1, in accordance with New Jersey Civil Service Commission procedures.

The inability of an employee in the Apprentice title to satisfactorily complete the training period and/or attain a level of performance warranting advancement to the title of Weights and Measures Inspector 1, shall be considered cause for separation from employment.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations for experience and education will be based upon the resume and unofficial transcripts submitted at the time of application. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide a CSC approved evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency, with a course-by-course breakdown, prior to the closing date (see CSC foreign degree information). Failure to do so may result in disqualification of your education towards eligibility.

SAME APPLICANTS: If you are applying under the NJ CSC "SAME" program, your Schedule A or B letter must be submitted along with your resume and any other required supporting documents indicated on the announcement by the closing date indicated below.
