NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the limited supervision of the Administrator of Investigations or another supervisory official in the New Jersey Racing Commission ("NJRC"), will provide investigative support to the Investigations Unit of NJRC. Performs regulatory inspections of licensed farms and racetracks and investigates non-compliance with racing statutes and regulations. Conducts investigative interviews, prepares investigative reports, reviews criminal history record information, and performs follow-up investigations to determine license eligibility. Assists in the development and implementation of a training program for NJRC investigators and performs other related duties. This position may require non-traditional work hours, on an as needed basis, including evenings and/or weekends on short deadlines for certain assignments, with or without advance notice.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience conducting background or criminal type investigations including the review and analysis of financial and accounting records.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as required on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree or certification as a Certified Public Accountant may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates with prior experience in the horse racing industry.

<u>SAME APPLICANTS</u>: If you are applying under the NJ CSC "SAME" program, your Schedule A or B letter must be submitted along with your resume and any other required supporting documents indicated on the announcement by the closing date indicated below. Failure to do so may result in disqualification of your education towards eligibility.
